

REPORTABLE ENERGY CONSUMPTION, INTENSITY AND GREENHOUSE GAS EMISSIONS

Ontario Regulation 25/23, *Broader Public Sector: Energy Reporting and Conservation and Demand Management Plans*, establishes energy reporting and conservation-planning requirements for prescribed public agencies in Ontario. These requirements support improved understanding and management of energy consumption and greenhouse gas emissions across the broader public sector.

Under Ontario Regulation 25/23, prescribed public agencies must submit annual summaries of energy consumption and greenhouse gas emissions to the Ministry through ENERGY STAR Portfolio Manager. Reports are due by July 1 of the year following the reporting year. The regulation applies to municipalities, municipal service boards, eligible post-secondary educational institutions, public hospitals, and school boards.

In 2026, broader public sector (BPS) organizations submitted energy consumption and greenhouse gas emissions information for the calendar year ending December 31, 2025. Reporting includes each applicable type of energy purchased and consumed to operate the reported facilities, including electricity, natural gas, propane, diesel, and fuel oil, as applicable.

Reporting period: January 1, 2025 to December 31, 2025
