**Trillium Health Partners moves closer to building
The New Peter Gilgan Mississauga Hospital**

March 10, 2023 (MISSISSAUGA, ON) – Today, Infrastructure Ontario (IO) and Trillium Health Partners (THP) announced the start of the development phase for The Peter Gilgan Mississauga Hospital. IO and THP signed a Development Phase Agreement (DPA) with ED+PCL Healthcare Partners, the Development Partner selected to further develop the project requirements and design, schedule, pricing, and risk management. The development phase follows an open, fair, and competitive Request for Proposal (RFP) process that began in April 2022 and was awarded to ED+PCL Healthcare Partners after extensive evaluation.

The Peter Gilgan Mississauga Hospital project is being delivered using a progressive public-private partnership (P3) approach, which will see ED+PCL Healthcare Partners work collaboratively with IO and THP under the DPA, as well as with the Ministry of Health. Once the Development Phase is complete, in approximately two years, it is expected that ED+PCL Healthcare Partners will enter into a fixed-price Project Agreement with THP to finalize design, build, finance and maintain the project, and proceed into the implementation phase for construction of the project.

Over the next 20 years, THP will experience more demand for its services than any other hospital in Ontario. *Trillium HealthWorks*, announced in December 2021, is the largest health care infrastructure renewal in Canadian history and will help meet the health care needs of the growing communities of Peel region and West Toronto areas. *Trillium HealthWorks* includes building The Peter Gilgan Mississauga Hospital, and expanding the future home of The Gilgan Family Queensway Health Centre. THP's plan to create a new kind of health care for a healthier community means advancing health across the hospital, the system and the community.

The start of the Development Phase marks the next major milestone in the process towards building The Peter Gilgan Mississauga Hospital. The new hospital will include:

- New and expanded Emergency Department (ED) – creating one of the largest EDs in the province
- Surgical platform that provides flexibility to adapt to changing patient needs and new technologies, including an increase in the number of surgical operating rooms with specialized equipment and advanced imaging systems
- New advanced diagnostic imaging facilities
- New pharmacy and clinical laboratory

Early works on the project, including the construction of the new parking garage, began in summer 2021. Hospital construction is currently estimated to begin in 2025, subject to the builder's construction schedule.
