

Discharge Process from Hospital to Home

Once ready to leave the hospital, your care team will work with you, your family, and/or your Substitute Decision Maker to safely return home, for those who are able to do so. The journey from hospital to home may look as follows:



1
You have been admitted to hospital.



2
You will be given a bed when one is available. Some or all your care may take place outside of a regular room.



3
If the best bed to care for you is available at one of our other sites, you *may* be transported.



4
Your progress will be checked every day and a discharge plan will be discussed.



5
Your care team will assess and coordinate with our community partners for your post-care needs such as bathing, injections, dressing care, medications and more.



6
Arrangements should be made for someone to pick you up on your discharge day.



7
It is recommended to make a follow-up appointment with your family doctor to review any questions, medications or changes to your health.
