Receives international designation from the Registered Nurses' Association of Ontario

May 9, 2017 – (Mississauga, ON) –Trillium Health Partners (THP) is proud to recognize its more than 3,800 incredible nurses during National Nursing Week. This year's theme **#YESThisIsNursing**, draws attention to the expanding traditional and non-traditional roles, settings and sectors nurses work in each and every day.

THP kicked off the week with Nurse of the Year Award ceremonies, where more than 90 nurses received an award for their leadership, teamwork and the exceptional care they provide to patients and families in our community.

This year, THP is celebrating its re-designation as a Best Practice Spotlight Organization (BPSO) for 2017-2019 from the Registered Nurses' Association of Ontario (RNAO). This international distinction recognizes THP's commitment to clinical excellence serving patients and families in Mississauga and West Toronto.

On Thursday, May 11, THP will host a panel presentation on BPSO best practices and to discuss the importance of partnering with patients and families in designing how the hospital delivers care in specific areas, such as caring for older adults with dementia and managing end-of-life care.

- THP received its first Best Practice Spotlight Organization (BPSO) designation from the RNAO in 2015. The designation is internationally recognized and reviewed every two years to ensure an organization's commitment to best clinical practices.
- The RNAO's Best Practice Guidelines Program is funded by the Ministry of Health and Long-Term Care, and was launched in 1999 to provide the best available evidence for patient care across a wide range of health care settings.
- Best Practice Guidelines currently implemented by THP include:

 - Reducing Foot Complications for People with Diabetes
 - Prevention of Falls and Fall Injuries in the Older Adult

 - Care Giving Strategies for Older Adults with Delirium, Dementia and Depression*
 - End of Life Care During the Last Days and Hours*
 - Preventing and Managing Violence in the Workplace*
