MISSISSAUGA (June 20, 2013) – Yesterday, Trillium Health Partners unveiled its new, 6,200 sq. ft. Neonatal Intensive Care Unit (NICU) located in the Mississauga Hospital. The state-of-the-art space, which provides the ultimate in safety, comfort and privacy, was made possible by local businessman and philanthropist, Peter Gilgan, who donated \$1.5 million towards the NICU, kick-starting the \$4-million project.

This unique and modern space is filled with colours and architectural elements inspired by nature – wood, water, light and stone. A large skylight and oversized windows flood the space with natural light and artwork and floors, which resemble hardwood, creating a comforting and soothing space for families. The new space supports the developmental needs of the most fragile patients while giving families access to amenities that include a washer and dryer, kitchenette, family lounge and shower.

Grateful families – like the Haq and Perrotta family, who spent time in the old NICU – were invited to the unveiling and had the opportunity to tour the new space.


